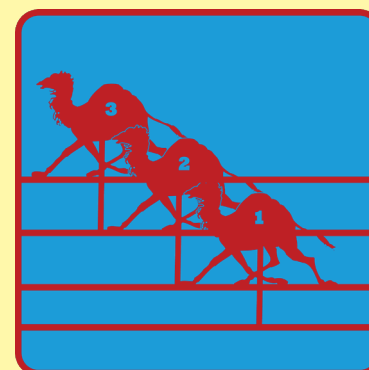

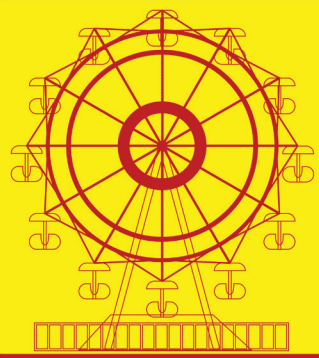

Plaza



The Plaza is the focal point of Intercamp! Everyday the Plaza will be the centre of action during the camp. 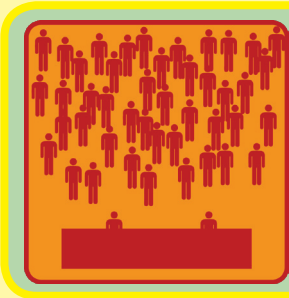

* Programs marked with an asterisk are called “Big Events” and they will take place in the Arena. For the Opening and Closing ceremony you will gather at your Subcamp Chief Tent from where you will be taken together in one large parade to the Arena. For the Scouts Own and IC2013 festival you have to go there yourself. Bring your flags, uniform and scarfs but please mind the Scouts behind you, they want to see the show as well!



On-site Activities



We have a great on-site programme ready for you. During the day we have around fourty activities for you to do. These activities range from archery to a Punch Battle.

After arriving on the Intercamp campsite you will receive from your leader a map of the terrain, on the other side is room for you to receive stamps. You need to get stamps so you can earn your activity badge. When you have done all the games and earned the other stamps just come to the info stand on the plaza from Sunday 14:00 to receive your activity badge!

Hike



You will hike a trail of just over 13 kilometres. It will be a very green hike through pastures and forests, over hills and through valleys. There are 4 checkpoints during the hike. At each checkpoint there is a game or a task.

The scouts need to bring the following items:

- wear sensible walking shoes, the countryside is hilly and may be very muddy
- a day pack per scout containing:
 - o a hat or cap for protection against the sun or rain
 - o sunscreen
 - o 1 litre of water or other drink
 - o a Cup to drink from
 - o a rain coat
 - o a packed lunch and maybe a snack (there is no food on the checkpoints and there are no shops on the route)

Don't worry, your leaders will get a map and instruction for the Hike!

QR-Code Game



A special game where both your phone and general knowledge comes in handy!

Are you in the possession of a smartphone, or is there someone in your group that has one? Take it with you since you need a smartphone with QR-code reader app to play this game. On the Intercamp campsite there are 40 different QR-codes. Scan the codes and answer the questions on your answer form (Print it out yourself!). Did you find and answer all the questions? Visit the info stand on the plaza and earn a part of your activity badge!

Top IC2013 Tip: Consulting your fellow Scouts is sometimes very useful!
